What's in these terms?

These terms tell you the rules for using our website shiphamvalves.com ("our site").

Who we are and how to contact us

Shiphamvalves.com is a site operated by Shipham Valves Limited ("We"). We are a limited company registered in England and Wales under company number 2532854 and have our registered office at D Shed, West Building, 72 to 74 Humber Enterprise Park, Skua Road, Brough, East Yorkshire, HU15 1EQ.

By using our site you accept these terms

By using our site, you confirm that you have read and accept these terms of use and that you agree to comply with them.

If you do not agree to these terms, you must not use our site.

We may make changes to these terms
